It was a brilliant day and we loved seeing the children embrace the theme of the day.

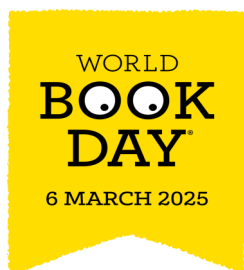
